Hello! So far Class 2 have had a great start to the new year, and have really immersed themselves into this half terms new topic; Arctic Adventures!

## **Reminders:**

- Reading at home Please remember, where possible, to read with your child at home and write
  this down in their reading journal. I have been counting the number of reads the children have,
  and will be recording this weekly. With Year 2 SATs growing closer, it is so important that the
  children are engaging with reading at home. We have also had one student in our class reach
  100 reads, and it would be lovely for more children to reach this as well! (Please remember we
  only count 1 read per day).
- Lost property I am gathering a collection of jumpers and cardigans in my classroom. If your child is missing anything, please feel free to come and have a look in the box at the end of the day, at home time.
- Times Tables Rockstars During the Spring term, we will be moving on to Multiplication and Division. Please encourage your child to spend time on TTRockstars, so that they become more confident with their timetables, particularly their 2s, 5s and 10s. Also, the person with the most points at the end of the week will get to be part of the Woodborough Woods Rock Band during the Shining Stars Assembly.
- School start time Every morning I welcome the children into class at 8:55, so that we can begin promptly at 9:00. I will be closing the door at 9:00, therefore if you arrive after this time, please take your child to the main reception to get their attendance mark.

## The Spring Term 1 Curriculum in Class 2:

We have lots of fun, different activities for the children to complete across the whole curriculum. Here is a little bit of information about what we will be covering in each subject.

- <u>English</u>: We will be reading and completing activities linked to the book 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers.
- <u>Maths:</u> Following the WhiteRose Maths scheme, we will finish off looking at Addition and Subtraction, and Shape. We will then move on to Multiplication and Division.



 <u>Science</u>: In Science we will be learning about Living Things and their Habitats, linking this to Polar animals.



- <u>Art:</u> The children will be learning about the work of Walter Mason, and using nature to create artwork to photograph.
- Geography: Class 2 will be learning about the North and South Poles their location, climate, and who lives there.
- <u>RE:</u> This half term we will be e finding answers to the big question 'What is the good news that Jesus brings?'.
- <u>PE:</u> The children will now have PE every Thursday and Friday afternoon, which will be delivered by our specialist PE coaches, Mr Mitchell and Mr Lacey. This term they will be learning the skills to play handball and rugby. Please make sure that your children wear their PE kits to school those days, and those with long hair have it tied up.
- <u>Computing:</u> During this half term, the children will be completing ICT on a Wednesday with Miss Attenborough. They will be learning about online safety.
- <u>PSHE:</u> We will be moving on to thinking about relationships.
