Summer 1 Curriculum

The information below will give you an overview of what areas we will be covering across the curriculum this term.

Maths – As we have finished the maths curriculum, we will be revising and revisiting key areas of maths across KS2. Post SATs, we will be providing the Children with the opportunity to apply their maths skills to a variety of different projects and developing skills in application and reasoning ready for year 7.

English – After finishing Beowulf, which the children are really enjoying, we will be reading and exploring some Viking myths and legends and creating or own.

History—We will be concluding our work on the Anglo-Saxons, before studying the Vikings. In particular we will be looking at invasion in Europe and the impact that the Vikings had on Britain. Our visit to the Jorvik Viking Centre will be an introduction to this theme.

Science – We will be concluding our work on the circulatory system and then investigating electricity. This will include looking at how different electrical circuits work and using symbols correctly.

Art/DT - We will be exploring Anglo-Saxon patterns and using Careful observation to inspire our own creations including illuminating our initials. We will then be using the Vikings as a focus for our art work, including making a boat with a working mechanism.

RE – This half-term, our theme will be 'Gospel' and we will be exploring the question ,What would Jesus do?' and exploring trust, forgiveness and justice.

Computing – In computing, we will be covering units on networks and quizzing.

Music/drama – After SATs, we will begin rehearsing for the summer show which we look forward to performing at the end of the school year in July. Children will also be involved in set design and helping to make props.
