This is because the Equality Act protects people against discrimination because of the protected characteristics that we all have. Under the Equality Act, there are nine Protected Characteristics: Age, Disability, Gender, Race, Religion or belief, Marriage or civil partnership, Sex, Sexual orientation, Pregnancy and maternity. 

DIEB House Ambassadors

To help promote good, positive behaviour in school, Woods Foundation has incorporated a 'House Points' system so that children are instantly rewarded for positive behaviour. Children and staff in school have all been placed in House Teams (Birch, Pine, Cedar and Maple) and each week they can earn points from any member of staff – this includes in the playground before school, lesson time, break times and lunchtimes. Each house will have a DIEB Ambassador that the children will learn about throughout the school year. House assemblies will take place at various times in the year to encourage further good behaviour and to explore their House Ambassador in more detail.
