

## DIEB House Ambassadors

To help promote good, positive behaviour in school, Woods Foundation has incorporated a 'House Points' system so that children are instantly rewarded for positive behaviour. Children and staff in school have all been placed in House Teams (Birch, Pine, Cedar and Maple) and each week they can earn points from any member of staff - this includes in the playground before school, lesson time, break times and lunchtimes.
