A homework grid will also be sent home with different tasks for the children to choose from. We had such a lovely time showing off all of Class 1's work at the end of last half-term!

Autumn 2 in Class 1:

Our Topic:



Class 1's Topic will be 'Toys'. We will be using the text 'Lost in the Toy Museum' to support our learning across the curriculum subjects this half-term.

PE Sessions:

P.E. will remain on a Thursday and Friday morning. The children will be doing Dance and Yoga this half-term.

<u>English</u>: We will be focusing on building pieces of writing including story writing and riddles. Our book 'Lost in the Toy Museum' will support us with this.

<u>Maths:</u> This half-term in Mathematics, we will be focusing on addition and subtraction. This includes understanding the 'Part-whole model'.

<u>Science</u>: Our topic in science is Materials. We will be exploring the different properties of materials and which materials are appropriate for different objects and their use.

<u>RE</u>: In RE we will be focusing on the importance of Christmas to Christians.

<u>History:</u> This half-term in History our topic is 'Toys'. This is a really exciting topic for the children! We will have the opportunity to look at old toys and modern toys to compare how they have changed over time.

Computing: Our topic in Computing this term is Pictograms.

<u>DT:</u> Our focus is 'Toy Puppets' in DT this half term. The children will have an opportunity to make their own toy puppet!
