



"I HAVE A DREAM"


HERE ARE SOME OF HIS MOST FAMOUS QUOTES

"I'm not interested in power for power's sake, but I'm interested in power that is moral, that is right and that is good."


"We must learn to live together as brothers or perish together as fools."

HIS EARLY LIFE

Luther's father was a prosperous businessman and when Luther was young, his father moved the family of 10 to Mansfeld in Germany. At age 5, he began his education at a local school where he learned reading, writing and Latin. At 13, Luther began to attend a school run by the Brethren of the Common Life in Magdeburg. He grew up as a paper boy. A paper boy is someone who delivers newspapers to people's homes.




BACKGROUND

He was born on 15 January 1929 in Atlanta, Georgia, United States. He died on 4 April 1968 [age 39] in Lorraine Motel, Tennessee, United States. He was 1.69 metres tall. His father was called Martin Luther King Sr and his mother was called Alberta Williams King.
