ROSA PARKS

BACKGROUND

Rosa Parks was born in Montgomery, Alabama. She sadly died on 24th October 2005. She is buried Detroit's Woodlawn Cemetery. She lived a happy young life with her mother, brother and grandparents.



SLAVERY

Rosa's grandparents used to tell her stories about slavery and how black people weren't able to live the way others could. Slavery was over but black people were still treated badly.



THE BUS JOURNEY

One day when Rosa was on her way home from the city traveling by bus a white person got on. The bus driver asked Rosa to move and stand instead but she refused to. After that she got arrested for what she did . Rosa got arrested for disorderly conduct(which means disturbing public peace)after prison she helped Detroit's Civil Rights Movement.
